The hottest looks in hair are right here! Check out the celeb styles we're loving, then read on for expert advice on how to score them from stylist Claude Boscher and colorist Alex Saldan at the Pierre Michel Salon in New York City.



**LOOK WE LOVE:** SHOULDER-LENGTH WAVES are hot this season—we especially like the ones we've seen on Jennifer Nettles and Olga Kurylenko.

**alex's color cue:** "She's a golden blonde with lighter blonde highlights around her face—it's the perfect way to have darker blonde and still get the beach blonde look in front."  
**claudes style secrets:** "This is a short, layered bob with side-swept bangs. To get the look, use a small curling iron to create waves by wrapping small pieces around the iron. Afterwards, do not brush through curls—just mist with a light hold spray and style with the fingers, then blow-dry bangs to the side and you're ready to go."

**alex's color cue:** "She's got a dark brown base with just a few golden highlights at the ends."  
**claudes style secrets:** "After a natural blow-dry using the fingers, curl hair slightly with an iron to create waves. Then, brush through the waves, tease hair at the crown for a bit of volume and add a light holding spray."

**alex's color cue:** "This is a great style for an elegant or casual night—she's got golden highlights with a slightly lifted base."  
**claudes style secrets:** "To obtain this look, you can start with a donut—a simple hair sponge that keeps the chignon in place. After securing hair around the donut with bobby pins, go back to the front piece and angle it to frame your face using a flat iron. Try Elnett Satin spray by L'Oréal to keep the look in place."

**alex's color cue:** "This natural color with beige highlights is a shade that doesn't need touchups too often—it's a perfect, elegant night look."  
**claudes style secrets:** "Separate hair at the top of the head, securing the lower part into a French seam. Begin to finger-curl the front of hair slowly, styling pieces back and away from the face—if you don't have a natural wave, grab a small curling iron and curl those top pieces."



**LOOK WE LOVE:** EASY UPDOS like the ones spotted on Hayden Panettiere and Kristin Chenoweth.



**LOOK WE LOVE:** GLAMMED-UP BRAIDS like Lauren Conrad's are something we predict tons of trendsetters will be sporting this spring.

**alex's color cue:** "This is a lightened base with golden blonde highlights—the color brightens her face."  
**claudes style secrets:** "You will need a large curling iron to create loose curls at the bottom; then, braid side sections back at the crown, clipping two together in back. This can also increase volume on top—hair gets a poof after you secure the braids. Use hairspray to hold it in place and a serum for shine."
