alex's color cue: "All-over honey highlights with her natural base is a beautiful color combination for her complexion."

claire's style secrets: "A slightly long, layered cut can get this look with a simple blow-dry using a medium round brush. Blow-dry hair forward to create face-framing rounded ends, part it down the middle and apply some volumizer at the roots to add oomph!"

alex's color cue: "This look has nice contrast with light, beige-y blonde highlights and natural roots showing through."

claire's style secrets: "A simple bob is flat-ironed straight down and flipped out at the edges. Shine serum maintains shine and healthy-looking hair, even after heat styling."

alex's color cue: "Jet black is a great color for someone with porcelain skin and it brings even more attention to her beautiful eyes."

claire's style secrets: "This style requires big bangs that are cut further up from the crown—they go straight across but the sides are slightly layered. The rest of her hair is flat-ironed and a shine serum adds a glossy finish."

alex's color cue: "Her rich, light brown color with golden highlights is alive with shine."

claire's style secrets: "After applying volumizer to the roots, blow-dry using a large round brush. A great way to add volume on top is to blow-dry hair forward, then hold the brush and hit it with a shot of cold air after it's dry. Bangs are blown forward to get a rounded effect and ends go under. It's a nice daytime look."
